

Current Sermon Series: Exodus

Today we resume our study in the book of Exodus. What we have already learned in this redemption story is that God rescued His people from slavery to set them apart for a living relationship with Him alone. What we will see over the next several weeks in chapters 21-40 is how God designates His people for His service by establishing His covenant with them through His law, by the sacrificial system, in the establishment of the tabernacle, and by the order of worship that magnifies God's name. All of this will reveal to us just how much faith in Christ alone is necessary to lead us into a deeper and fuller knowledge of God.
